The Clark County Medical Society (CCMS) President's Award is a long-standing tradition in which the outgoing president celebrates his year-long tenure by acknowledging achievements made by deserving medical professionals. One of our goals at CCMS is to raise awareness of the outstanding health care that is being provided in our community. In an effort to showcase the great work being done by a variety of healthcare and wellness professionals in Southern Nevada, CCMS has added three categories and will engage the community in the nomination process. By involving the public in the nomination process, we can cast a broader net and unveil some of our community's great unsung heroes in healthcare. This program has become an annual tradition, gaining momentum and prestige in the years ahead. The result will be a collection of nominations that tell the stories of the dedicated and exceptional professionals working in the healthcare and wellness fields.

The two selected **OPEN** Award Categories are: the **CCMS Winged Heart Awards** for public nominations in the areas of **Nursing** and **Health Related Nonprofit Organizations**. We will also have two **CLOSED** Award Categories: the **Student "Rising Star" Award** - Deans of Nevada medical schools submit nominations; and the traditional **President's Award** which will be awarded to a member of the community who he feels is visionary and is raising the bar for healthcare in Nevada.

- Nurse** Must be currently affiliated with a local practice or hospital and providing necessary services to patients, either on an inpatient or outpatient basis.
- Non-profit** Must be a registered non-profit organization that is related to medical/healthcare or promoting wellness in the community.

3. Nominations are submitted to Lupita.Abrew@clarkcountymedical.org
4. Nominations are accepted March 6th through May 5th, 2017.
5. CCMS past, current and president-elect make up the "Presidents' Committee" and review nominations.
6. Award Recipients are contacted by Friday, May 26, 2017
7. Award recipients (plus one guest) receive an invitation to the Installation Dinner & Awards Ceremony.

All nominees must be for individuals or organizations located in Clark County, Nevada. Family members or staffs of current, incoming or past CCMS presidents are not eligible to be nominated for an award. Other exclusions may apply.
